## Resident

- Concern regarding Bloxham Nursery application for change of use of the stables/ current mess room to a house, why had the PC objected. He thought this was wrong. We explained the issue and the facts around the withdrawal of the application by J.W. We also explained the principle of any dwellings being approved (new or change of use) that sit outside the current built up limits and the Policies in BNDP and Local Plan.
- Potholes around the village and Banbury generally and what's being done to improve them. We mentioned Fix My Street and also the extra money KM had talked of coming to help OCC and CDC on Road repairs.
- The naming of the Redrow development in Banbury as Bloxham Vale, could this be taken up with CDC to stop.

## Resident

- Notices and Fly posting around the village on lampposts etc. is getting out of hand. Can these be removed by residents? Is so can a message to go into the Broadsheet
- Rubbish Bins outside the shops are not being emptied again. Can we ask them to keep these emptied as once full the rubbish blows down the road?
- Gullies are still becoming blocked, outside the Ex-Serviceman's Hall to the corner with Stonehill risking flooding. Could OCC and KM be contacted to arrange for them to be cleared. Resident has offered to place cones at the site to enable Street sweeping to include this area, this is usually a problem as cars are parked.
- Front door at Saddlers House is now bricked up is there planning for this as part of the major refurbs being carried out.
- Parking on the stretch of pavement outside the Old White Lion to the corner of Humber Street, is awful and obstructing the pavements on occasion. Could KM be sked to check with Highways who the land owner is?
- Wheelie bins outside the houses in this area are on public in a conservation area is this allowed and can people be asked to move them?
- Rubbish outside the post office and cigarette buts outside the barbers again so could we ask them to tidy the area a bit please and request the Barbers to install a Cigarette bin?
- Parking on corners around the village is a danger to people making blind turns and also coming in and out of their drives with obscured views. Could we ask via the Broadsheet for people to be more considerate in their parking.
- Potholes around the village generally but also in particular the one by the man hole cover opposite the entrance to Stonehill. This is keeping people awake at night and also now shaking their house risking loosening the slates.
