Demolition of existing out buildings, proposed single storey rear and side and first floor rear extension, internal alterations, new porch and creation of parking and turning areas |

Environment/ Highways

- **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD IN THE JUBILEE PARK PLAY AREA, AS PER THE SIGNAGE**
- Residents are kindly requested not to leave wheelie bins at the front of their properties, if there was rear access. Bins should be put out and put away again on the day they were emptied. Bins should be stored within the curtilage of their properties and please could residents ensure that footpaths are not blocked by bins, at any time.
- Oxfordshire County Council is providing Civil Parking Enforcement Officers in the Cherwell area and it is hoped that they will monitor Bloxham for illegal parking. - Discussions will be held with a resident over the siting of a dog waste bin in Bloxham Grove Road.
- Investigations would be under taken into EV electric charging points and where there might be suitable locations to site them in the village.
- Thames Water were undertaking works at their site off The Ridgeway and concerns had been raised about the speed of vehicles using the track. A 10mph sign would be purchased and erected on this un-adopted road.
- Proposed white lining on the A361 and yellow lining on Courtington Lane would be chased up with the County Council.
- A base for the new bus shelter on the A361 would be laid by the end of May 2022. Then the shelter will follow shortly after.

Community

- A defibrillator is held internally at Warriner School, in the admin block outside the general office, it is in an unlocked cabinet and can be accessed during school hours. The second unit is in a climate-controlled cabinet, fixed externally on the sports hall, to the right of the main entrance. This one is locked, but there are clear instructions on the cabinet about how to get the required code. The defibrillators will be checked/maintained regularly by the school and should a defibrillator be used, the school must be notified immediately as the shock pads are single-use.
- A defibrillator is also located outside the Ex-Servicemen's Hall. In an emergency, please always call 999 in the first instance and the emergency services will judge whether or not it is appropriate to obtain the defibrillator and will then issue the access code to open the defibrillator cabinet.
